WBC (USA) LIGHTWEIGHT CHAMPION, RAY NARH, CALLS ON GHANA'S CONSUL GENERAL IN NEW YORK

The new King in Ghana and World Boxing, Raymond Narh, who demolished the ever-outspoken Angel Hernandez of the U.S. to win the WBC USNBC Lightweight title, paid a courtesy call on the Consul General, Hon.
